STOP AND PRAY

Holy Spirit, open my heart and my mind to Your truth today! Then help me to be a Doer of the Word and not a Hearer only!

- 1) Why do we sometimes hesitate to share the Gospel, even though we know we should?

Read Acts 8:26-29

- 2) What did the angel tell Philip to do? Where did he tell him to go?

- 3) How does Philip pursue evangelism? How does this inform us on how we can be pursuing evangelism? Why can it be difficult for us to share the Gospel with those around us?

Read Acts 8:30-35

- 4) What are the different ways we can see Jesus in the quotation from Isaiah? (vv. 32b-33)

5) Why is it important to bring every conversation from Scripture back to Jesus?

Read Acts 8:36-40

6) How does the eunuch respond to Philip's explanation of Scripture?

7) Why is the step of obedience in baptism so important for the Christian?

8) Read verse 31 again. There are people that God has for each of us to reach. How can we be looking for the areas of our lives where God would open doors for Gospel conversation?

Take time to pray for each other.

Use this prayer as the theme of your prayer time: *"Father in Heaven, thank you for the Gospel of Jesus that saved me. I know that you call me to share the Gospel with those around me. Forgive me for when I miss the opportunity because I think that it isn't my place to preach. Help me to see the people in my life that you have for me to reach! Thank you for those people who shared the Gospel with me. Help me to be bold in sharing my faith and the message of Jesus with those around me."*
